GP Engagement in Community Health Checks

As part of CHPCP the distribution of ‘Sustaining Community Wellbeing in Drought’ funds, North East Division of General Practice will be encouraging General Practitioners in the Central Hume PCP catchment to be part of community events where Health Checks are to be offered.

The process for requesting a General Practitioner is:

1. The Division will require notice of your event 10 weeks prior.
(To give GP enough time to arrange schedules)
2. Confirmation of availability of a GP will be given within 6 weeks of request
3. Contact Helen Mansfield at North East Victorian Division of General Practice on 5762 2444 to obtain a GP attendance request form.

Details that will be required include;

- Date
 - Time required to begin and end
 - Role - e.g. Health Check, just mingle with crowd, etc
 - Venue
 - Target Group
 - Any other relevant information
4. Les Hume, Community Support Worker for the North East Victorian Division of General Practice will endeavor to find a General Practitioner to participate.
 5. An evaluation of the event will be required by the Division following the event.
