

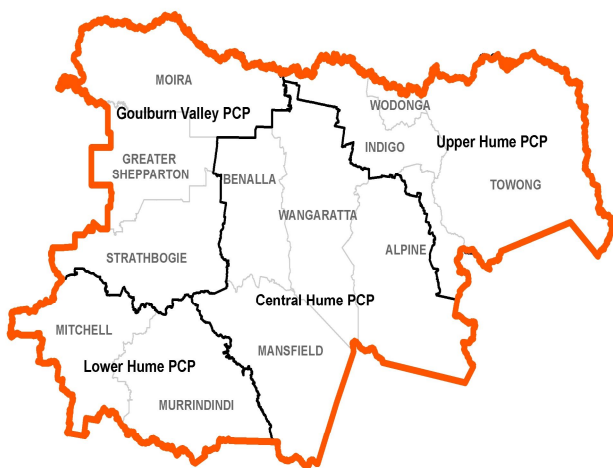
Hume Region Aboriginal Population

Hume Region is one of eight regions in Victoria and spans 12 Local Government Areas. The 12 LGAs are grouped into four Primary Care Partnership planning areas:



- Lower Hume - includes Mitchell and Murrindindi LGAs
- Goulburn Valley - includes Moira, Shepparton and Strathbogie LGAs
- Central Hume - includes Alpine, Benalla, Mansfield and Wangaratta LGAs
- Upper Hume – includes Indigo, Towong and Wodonga LGAs

Albury is a New South Wales cross-border Local Government Area that shares health services with Wodonga. Albury population is included in the population statistics to assist planning*.

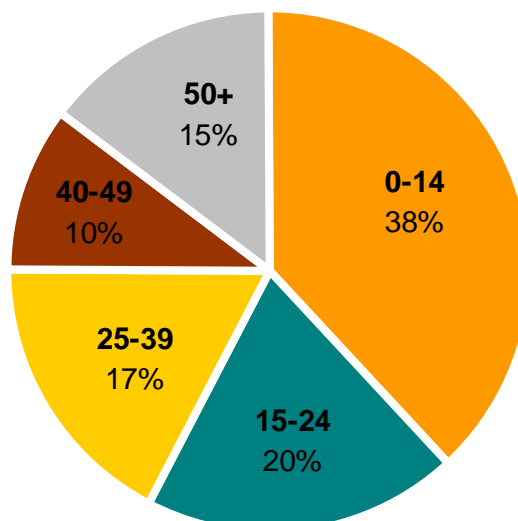
